It is with great pride and honor that I stand before you today, as the Company Commander for Excelsior High School, to present the Cadet Unit's term in review and highlight our many achievements. The Cadet Unit had its first parade since the COVID 19 global pandemic, on December 19, 2022. The first parade with an **all-female platoon**, the first parade for **five batches of senior cadets** and our newest batch of recruits who were successful in their respective examinations.



The parade was also in celebration and honour of a man, who we credit for paving the way for us and causing our name to be mentioned in rooms that we could not step foot in. **Major Audley N. Harris**, JP, was an integral part of many of our experiences, growth and development as a cadet. He encouraged us to dream big, to be confident and to lead with honor and integrity. He is our former company commander, who mentored us through our younger cadet years. He saw the leader in us before we were even leaders. He was and still is a part of all our important milestones.

The country went into lock down in 2020 and opened partially in September of 2021. Just like all other institutions, the Jamaica Combined Cadet Force was also not speared from its effects. Due to the innovativeness of our NCOs, the Excelsior Cadet Unit was one of the first cadet units to have recruited and published its cadets in the entire Cadet Force. Within 8 months, we have completed 5 intakes with a total of 150 recruits, a 90% success rate. Due to this successful program while in lock down, our cadet unit skyrocketed to 141 members from 60 members.

Our unit's strength of 141 was put to the test when our cadet unit was called upon to provide majority of the cadets, for participation, on short notice for three concurrent activities.

- 1. National Memorial Service and Remembrance Day Parade (National Heroes Park)
- 2. The Second Battalion Founder's Day Service (Pentecostal Gospel Temple, Windward Road)
- 3. Funeral Service for the Late Cadet Campbell, Michion (Kings Chapel, Windward Road).

This all occurred during the cadets' mid-term examinations, to ensure the baton was taken up and carried properly, approval was sought and granted to do their respective examinations later. This provided the security and confidence needed for the cadets to carry out their duties in ensuring standard and proper representation. I

want to commend all the cadets who answered the call to ensure the Battalion, the Regiment and the Cadet Force were well represented, displaying great leadership and selflessness in spite of their school examinations.

I am pleased to announce that four members of the Excelsior High Cadet Unit received Commendation from the Commandant of the Jamaica Combined Cadet Force.

The Cadet Force had its first **Administrative Inspection** Island wide and the Excelsior High Cadet Unit was reported to have the best system in accountability and record management across the island. I am pleased to announce that Excelsior High Cadet Unit came out as

- 2. Number 1 across the Eastern Regiment (Region) and
- 3. Number 1 among 111 schools across the Force (Island).

The successes we have achieved would not have been possible without the contributions of the school and its administration such as the Principal Mr. Deanroy Bromfield, our Vice principals, Ms. Christine Hunter and Mrs. Grey-Tomlinson, the Bursary Department, Ex-cadets and Parents who continue to go above and beyond. The backbone of it all, is my training team that comprise of S/Sgt. Higgins and Mr. Cunningham, who have worked tirelessly to provide mentorship, supervision, and guidance to each and all the 141 cadets. *Thank you for serving alongside me and contributing significantly to the unit's successes*.

Cadets your dedication and hard work are commendable, keep being role models and examples among your peers, I am proud of you all, well done.

Congratulations to the cadets who were promoted to Sergeant and Corporals and a *special congratulations to* our Adult Instructor Staff Sergeant Higgins, Ricardo on his recent promotion.

In closing, as we celebrate the festive season in our own way. I want to take this opportunity to wish you all a Merry Christmas and a prosperous 2023. **Be kind, be brave, be honorable, be respectful and most of all serve with compassion and integrity**. 




