- a. Candidates taking the Alternate Paper 03/2 to SBA in the CAPE Sciences are permitted to take into the exam room notebooks and/or any materials relevant to the practical examination. When responding to the appropriate question, candidates may refer to their prepared notes.
- b. Please note the Supervisor's Reports and Instructions for Setting up Labs should be shared 2 weeks ahead of the examinations for candidates taking the Alternate Paper 03/2 to SBA in the CAPE Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics).
